"In Full View of the Creator as our witness, We, as American  
Citizens, assembled together, do hereby dedicate and consecrate  
our lives to uphold, preserve and defend the Constitution for the  
United States of America;

We duly acknowledge: The Declaration of Independence is the  
Founding Philosophy of our Nation by which we abide; the  
Constitution of the United States of America is the Governing Body  
of Law which Protects the People of this Land; the Bill of Rights is  
the Order of the Rights of Free Men.

Through these, the greatest governing documents ever given to  
mankind, our Founding Fathers have made an Eternal Record of  
the Will of the People to be Free. We carry their Sacred Trust  
forward as we face the crisis of this time, knowing our allegiance to  
the Principles contained therein will Resolve our National Distress.

We join with millions of other Americans, to hold our elected and  
appointed officials accountable to our Federal (and State)  
Constitutions.

We stand together as ONE VOICE today, and reaffirm our devotion  
to the Love of God and Country, the Cause of Liberty and the  
Brotherhood of Man, and to our Union. We ask our Creator to guide  
us, and give us Aid and Comfort, Illumination and Protection, to

# The Liberty Walk Program consists of two (2) *(folded)* double-sided printed pages.

## How to Print this .PDF Program Document:

1. If you need **10 (ten) copies** of the event Program, **print \*\*11\*\* ELEVEN copies of (.PDF) PAGE #1 (*only*)**.
2. RELOAD those 11 printed pages into your printer's paper tray so you can print the "blank" side.
3. **Print ONE test page copy of (.PDF) PAGE #2.**  
If it prints on the correct feed page surface AND aligns properly front to back, print the remaining 10 pages of (.PDF) PAGE #2. **If needed, adjust the copies in the paper tray** so they will print properly. Repeat the test if necessary. You should now have 10 double-sided pages of PAGE #1 and PAGE #2, back to back.
4. **Repeat for (.PDF) PAGES #3 and #4.** Note the Lyrics and Walk cadences were designed to print on the same page surface to avoid confusion using them at the Walk event.
5. Fold the pages in half and assemble, nested together as a "booklet"
