I believe in The United States of America, as a
Government, of the people, by the people, for the people;
Whose just powers are derived from the consent of the gov-
erned; a democracy in a Republic; a sovereign Nation of many
sovereign States; a perfect Union, one and inseparable; estab-
lished upon those principles of freedom, equality, justice and
humanity, for which American
Patriots sacrificed their lives and fortunes.

I therefore believe it is my duty to my Country, to love It;
to support Its Constitution; to obey Its Laws; to respect
Its Flag; and to defend It against all enemies.
